Wonderful views from Bren Tor to Yes Tor |

| 11.07.24 Lydia Baretto 7.2 miles | Cold East car park OS Grid Ref: SX 74037 74241 Coypool Park & Ride car share | Climb Rippon Tor, Top Tor and Pil Tor before visiting the very interesting church at Buckland on the Moor via Pudsham Down, Buckland Beacon and Ten Commandments Stone. A couple of steep climbs but well worth the effort to admire the wonderful views. |
